About this message

The Journey of an Ever Increasing Faith teaches how God's Word grows in a believer's heart and produces spiritual fruit when faith is guarded, spoken, and patiently practiced.

In this Tagalog/Taglish Christian sermon, the message begins with the disciples' prayer, "Increase our faith," and explains that even mustard-seed faith must continue growing. Using the biblical picture of seed and soil, the sermon shows why the condition of the heart matters, how negative words can uproot what God has planted, and why believers must remain anchored in God's promises while waiting for healing, provision, protection, breakthrough, and other manifestations of faith.

The message also encourages Christians to guard their hearts from bitterness, anger, unforgiveness, offenses, fear, and worldly influences. Faith is not passive. It must be acted upon through hearing God's Word, planting it in the heart, speaking in agreement with it, nurturing it patiently, and refusing to quit when circumstances appear contrary to God's promise.

In this message, you will learn:

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- Why believers must continue growing in faith
- How God's Word works like seed planted in the heart
- Why the condition of your heart affects spiritual fruit
- How spoken words can nurture or uproot faith
- Why patience and perseverance are necessary before manifestation
- How to respond to fear, negative reports, sickness, lack, and difficult circumstances
